

# BOARD HIGHLIGHTS

Special recognition was given to Aaron Makatura and Michael Nolan for achieving the status of Eagle Scout.

The Board approved the following items at their March 21, 2011 Board meeting:

- Approved the Treasurer's Report, Bill List and Tax Refunds.
- Approved the assessment settlements negotiated by Andrews & Price on Lot and Block 160-L-81 and 160-L-79.
- Approved the following use of facility requests:
  - a. Approved the request to host the Marching Band Festival on Saturday, October 22, 2011, at Northgate Alumni Field.
  - b. Approved the request of the Greater Pittsburgh Football Association to use the High School music room and one classroom or conference room from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. for their meetings on the following Wednesdays: July 27, August 3, 17, 31, September 14, 28, and October 12, 2011.
  - c. Approved the building use request for Alumni Field from March 23, 2011 to the end of the school year from 3:05 to 4:05 p.m. for a coed elementary running club, sponsored by parents of Bellevue Elementary School. This is a non-school sponsored activity and is contingent upon submission of proper insurance coverage.
- Accepted the supplemental resignations of David Sylvester as Head Girls' Basketball Coach, and Torey O'Donnell, as First Assistant Girls' Basketball Coach. Also, the Board accepted the resignation of Dan Sefick as Assistant Football Coach and as 7th grade Boys' Basketball Coach.
- Approved the request to conduct a cheerleading camp July 20-22, 2011 at the Middle/High School gym from 7:45 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. All three squads will attend camp together; each will learn different material. The fee is \$125 per cheerleader.

- Approved Rachel Dombrowski and Erika Hill as Instructor Aides for the Northgate Community Swim Program for the remainder of the 2010-11 school year.
- Approved Administration to establish a cut-off date after which the District may assign kindergarten student enrollees to either Avalon or Bellevue Elementary Schools in an attempt to balance class sizes.
- Approved an Agreement with Mercy Behavioral Health to provide a Student Assistance Program Liaison and school-based services to Avalon and Bellevue Elementary Schools.
- Approved the proposed 2011-12 Allegheny Intermediate Unit Program of Services Budget as presented. There is no increase in the District's allocation for this proposed budget.
